## About KCSE

The Korean Council of Science Editors (KCSE) is a non-profit organization established in 2011 with the goal of improving the quality of scientific journals in Korea and strengthening their international position. KCSE has been a regional chapter of EASE since 2022, and this poster aims to engage international editors and researchers by highlighting KCSE's mission and key activities. KCSE leads the development of scholarly journal publishing in Korea by providing various workshops and disseminating guidelines, aiming to strengthen the skills of editors and establish a sound research publishing culture. Over the past decade, increasing awareness and adherence to publication ethics has also been a main focus; through active communication with the international publishing community in North America, Europe, and Asia. KCSE systematically supports the research publishing environment in Korea through a range of activities, such as operating a professional manuscript editor certification system, providing indexing support, and developing editorial guidelines.



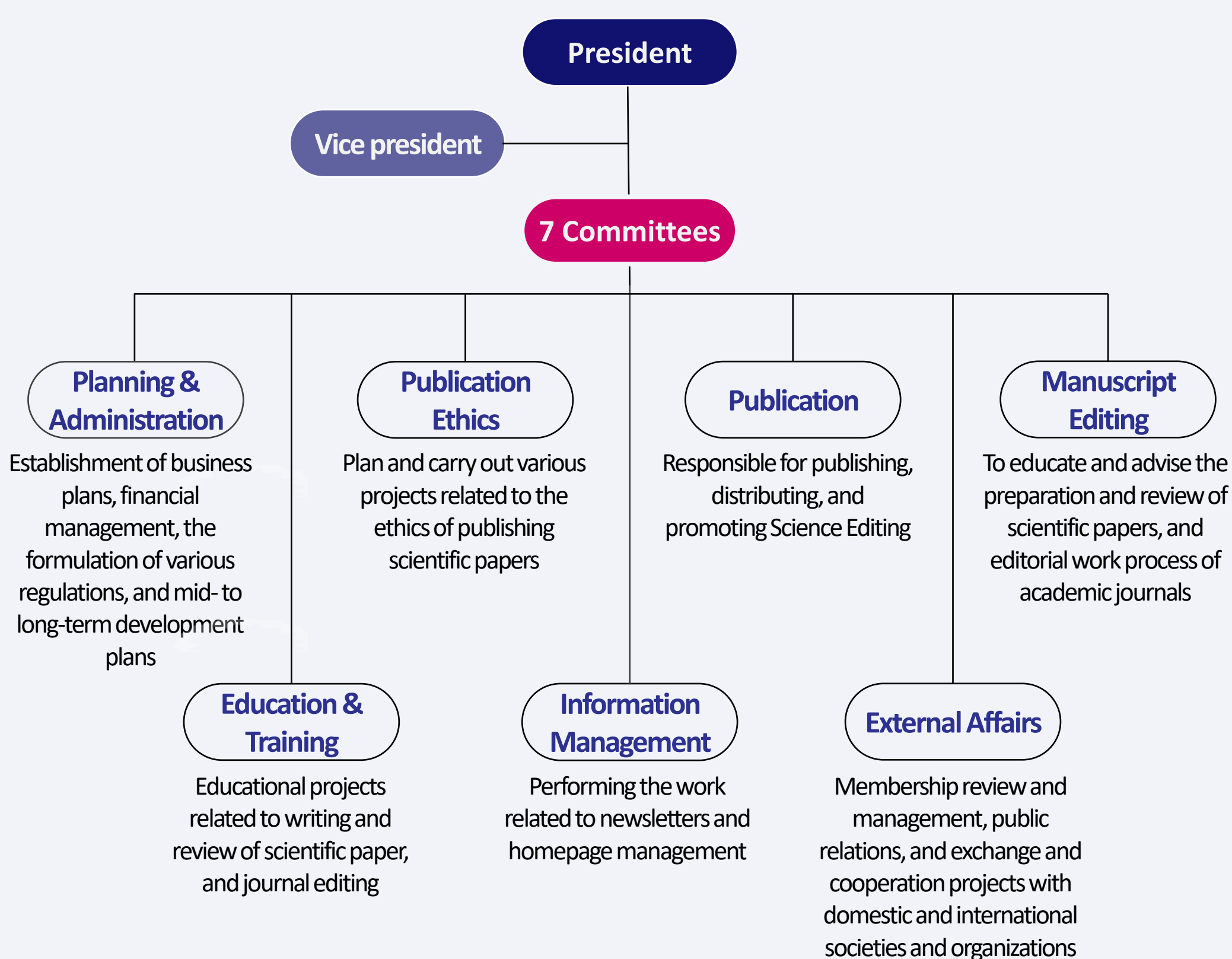
## Mission and Vision

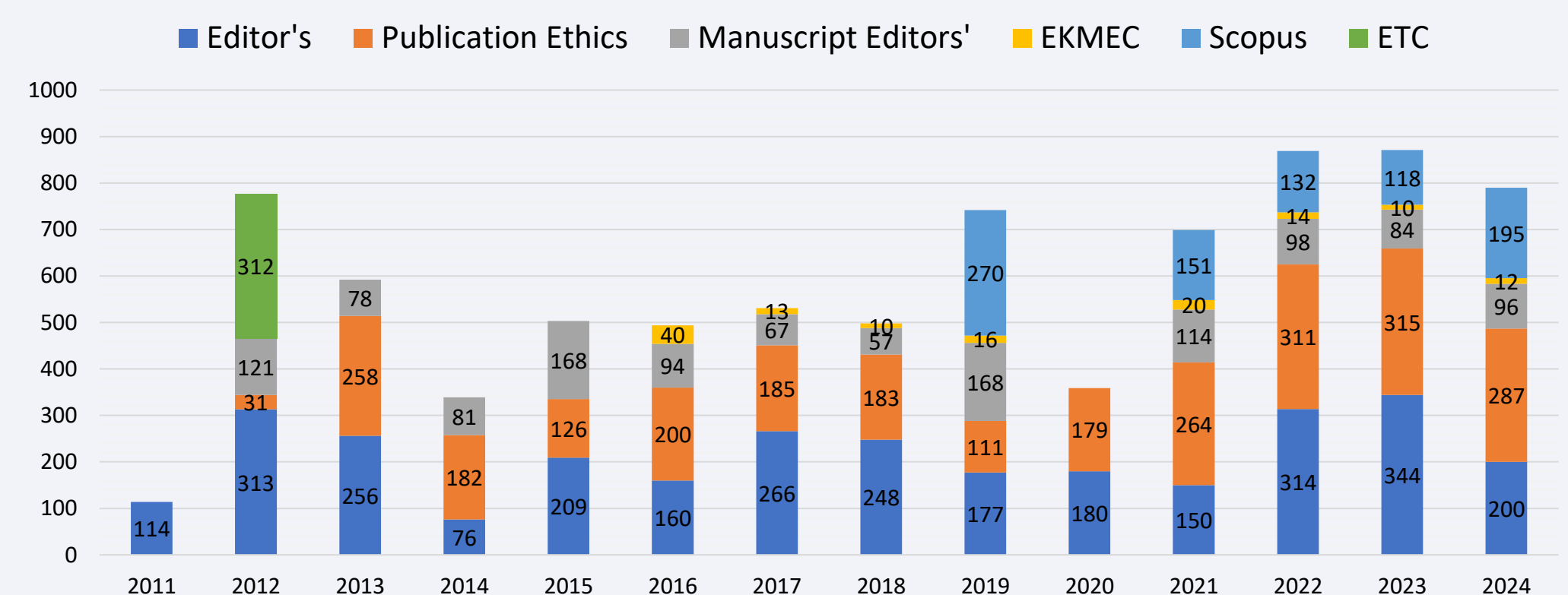
## What do we do
