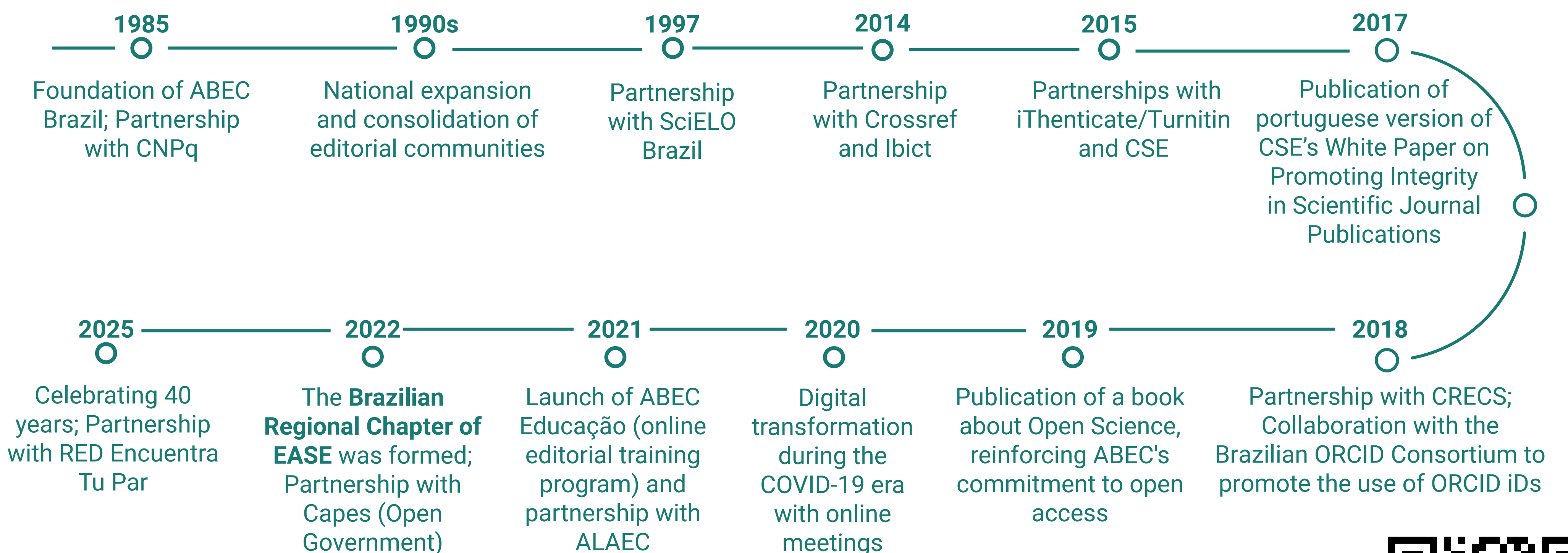


## About ABEC Brazil

The Brazilian Association of Science Editors (ABEC Brazil) is a non-profit organization that supports the professionalization of scientific publishing in Brazil. Founded in 1985, ABEC has become the country's leading forum for promoting best practices, ethics, and innovation in scientific publishing.

## A story of vision and collaboration

In 1985, a group of editors came together with a common goal: to advance Brazilian science through editorial excellence. That year, ABEC Brazil was born. Over the course of four decades, ABEC has helped shape national scientific communication by providing training, fostering ethics, and integrating Brazilian journals into international networks. Amid global challenges, ABEC stands firm—adapting to digital changes, supporting open science, and defending scientific quality and integrity. Its online certification program — ABEC Educação — is designed for editors, peer reviewers, and librarians, offering over 450 hours of training in a flexible and modular format. With a global presence, ABEC Brazil is a partner of organizations such as Crossref, iThenticate/Turnitin, Council of Science Editors, enabling Brazilian periodicals to have greater international visibility. The Association also collaborates with SciELO Brazil and other Open Access initiatives, contributing to the standardization of editorial workflows, the development of ethical guidelines, and the advancement of scientific communication across multiple disciplines. Today, with 1,359 members, 695 associated journals, and diverse institutional partnerships, ABEC Brazil symbolizes collaboration and transformation in scientific publishing.
