In 1985, a group of editors came together with a common goal: to advance Brazilian science through editorial excellence. That day, ABEC Brazil was born. Over the course of four decades, **ABEC** has helped shape national scientific communication by providing training, fostering ethics, and integrating Brazilian journals into international networks. Amid global challenges, **ABEC** stands firm —adapting to digital changes, supporting open science, and defending scientific quality and integrity. Today, with 1,411 members, 1,089 associated journals, and diverse institutional partnerships, ABEC Brazil symbolizes collaboration and transformation in scientific publishing.
